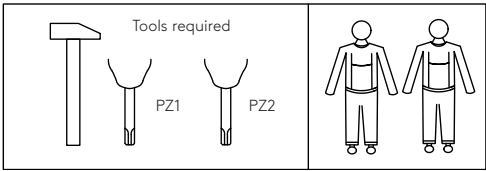
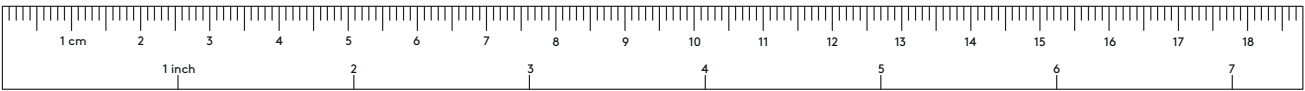
- The manufacturer's assembly instructions must be followed in detail to ensure the safety features of the cot are not compromised.

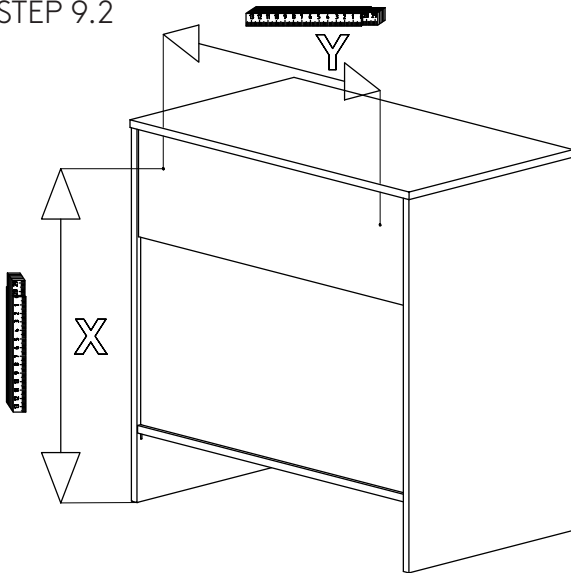
# PREVENTION OF TIPPING OVER

Wall mounting is required. As wall materials vary, screws for fixing to wall are not included. For advice on suitable screw systems, contact your local specialised dealer.

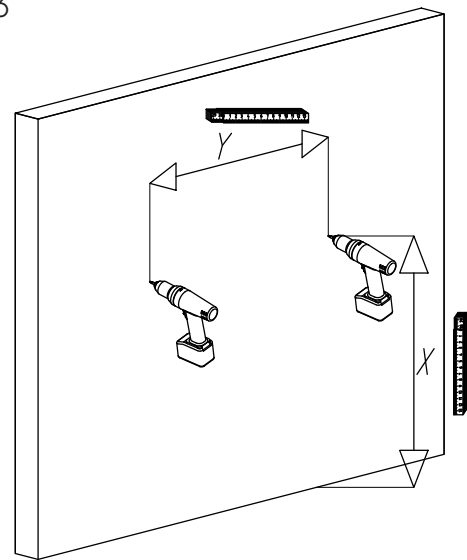
